How We Collaborate

City of Austin & Travis County

Provide bonds and general fund dollars to expand housing and services. Provide vouchers to support housing various populations including people with disabilities.

Communities for Recovery

We collaborate to support individuals who experience homelessness and substance use disorder through peer coaching. We also provide funding for peer support services.

Federally Qualified Health Centers

We collaborate to provide integrated care (primary and behavioral health), including specialty care like Medication Assisted Treatment.

ECHO

We fund coordinated assessments and community coordination efforts with state grant dollars. We collaborate to monitor and ensure best practice interventions for our homeless community.

Mobile Loaves & Fishes

Integral Care operates the Topfer Health Resource Center and provides behavioral healthcare services to the residents of Community First! Village.

Landlords

We partner with Travis County landlords and apartment associations to make available safe and affordable homes to move individuals from homeless to housed.

Our housing services are a pathway to recovery for people experiencing homelessness and living with mental illness, substance use disorder and intellectual and developmental disabilities.
