Who is Eligible

- ___ Your child and the child's legally authorized guardian
- ___ Proof of current insurance / your current insurance card
- ___ Current SSI award letters for everyone in your household who receives it
- ___ Proof of residence (must be Travis County) lease agreement, utility bill, ID
- ___ Parent's photo ID
- ___ Social Security card for your child
